# Guidance Notes

## Requirements for Membership of the IET

If you have engineering qualifications or are working in an engineering environment, you may be eligible to become a Member of the IET and be entitled to use the designatory letters TMIET or MIET after your name.

To be awarded designatory letters you must satisfy the IET that you:

- (a) have achieved an acceptable standard of knowledge and understanding gained through education and/or experience;
- (b) are professionally engaged in one of the many science, engineering or technology fields within the scope of the Institution;

In addition, you must supply details of someone who will support your application by confirming that you are a suitable candidate to use the IET's designatory letters after your name. Your supporter can be your employer, a member of the IET, or someone else who knows you in a work capacity. If they are not themselves entitled to use the designatory letters FIET, MIET or TMIET, the IET will write to them to ask them to verify that they support your application and your application for TMIET/MIET will be assessed when their response is received.

If you were formerly a student member of the IET, or one of its founding institutions IEE or IIE, and your membership has been continuous since you completed your studies, then you do not need a supporter. However you do need to send copies of your certificates to show that you have completed your qualifications.

## Knowledge and Understanding

The qualifications MEng, MSc, PhD, NVQ 5, BEng, BSc, NVQ 4, CSCS/ECS Platinum Card, are deemed as sufficient evidence that you have achieved an acceptable standard of knowledge and understanding for MIET.

The qualifications ONC, OND, HNC, HND, CSCS/ECS Gold Card, Advanced Modern Apprenticeship, Level 3 NQF, Level 6 (SQCF), Foundation Degree, City and guilds 236 (Electrical Installation or similar), City and Guilds Higher Professional Diploma in Engineering are deemed as sufficient evidence that you have achieved an acceptable standard of knowledge and understanding for TMIET.

If you do not have one of these specific qualifications then, for either MIET or TMIET, you need to provide a copy of your CV which clearly details your present employment position, previous employment positions and any roles, responsibilities and other qualifications that are relevant to the interests of the IET. Please note that the IET reserves the right to request a detailed CV from any applicant.

An assessment is then made by a specially trained member of staff. In order to award MIET, the IET is looking for evidence of work at graduate level that clearly shows you have the detailed knowledge and understanding of the fundamental engineering principles that underlie your work. For TMIET, the IET is looking for sufficient work experience and responsibilities as a technician which has enabled you to develop the knowledge equivalent to a formal technical qualification.

## IET's Right to Withdraw Designatory Letters

If you supply misleading information in order to gain entitlement to use designatory letters, then the IET reserves the right to withdraw your right to use the letters and may withdraw your membership.

## All Members

All members of the IET must agree to comply with the IET's Royal Charter and Byelaws and Rules of Conduct. By agreeing to these they are providing assurance of their professionalism and their commitment to ethical and moral conduct to their clients, colleagues or employers.
